MeshPower develops and operates solar powered minigrids. The mini-grids are hybrid Alternating Current (AC) and Direct Current (DC) grids. In Rwanda MeshPower currently operates 70 mini-grids in the Eastern Province.

MeshPower focuses on three areas in Rwanda: cost effective electricity provision to domestic consumers, the provision of productive use cases to businesses and entrepreneurs and the provision of internet access in target villages.

During a site visit to one of MeshPower's largest grids in Bugesera District, guests will get the chance to see all three focus areas in operation.
